## DECISION no. 32 of 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2016

Approving the List of projects proposed for approval, rejection and re-evaluation, submitted in the second call for proposals for the Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme - September Deadline - 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2016

## Having regard to the following:

- The articles 47 and 49 of Regulation (EU) no. 1303/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2013 laying down common provisions of the European Regional Development Fund, the European Social Fund, the Cohesion Fund, the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development and the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund and laying down general provisions on the European Regional Development Fund, the European Social Fund, the Cohesion Fund and the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund and repealing Council Regulation (EC) No 1083/2006
- The section 5.3 of Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme,
- The article 2 from the Rules of Procedures of the Monitoring Committee for Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme,

the Monitoring Committee of the Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme has adopted this:

## **DECISION**

- **Article 1** The present document approves the List of approved projects, rejected projects and of the projects proposed for re-evaluation, submitted in the second call for proposals for the Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme -deadline for projects 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2016.
- Article 2 Annex 1 "List of applications approved for financing", Annex 2 "List of rejected projects" and Annex 3 "List of the projects proposed for re-evaluation" are enclosed to this document and are part of this decision.
- Article 3 For contracting purposes Managing Authority has the right to make adjustments to the approved projects (including in the budget) and to ask the project partners for new relevant documents and information, additionally to the received clarifications and to the modifications made by the assessment working group.
- Article 4 The Monitoring Committee shall be duly informed regarding these changes if any and its approval shall be requested for major changes as defined by the Rules of Procedure.

**Article 5** - The Monitoring Committee shall be fully informed on the results of the revaluation process of the applications included in Annex 3, and shall decide on their selection or rejection according to the Programme rules.

**Article 6** - For Priority Axis 4 and Priority Axis 5 is created a reserve list for selected projects without available financial allocation.
